Peacock Socks

Socks worked in Mosaic Stitch introduce color and add warmth.

Materials: 50 gr. fingering weight sock yarn in solid color (MC)

50 gr. fingering weight sock yarn self-patterning stripe, or small amounts of at least 5 colors to form background stripes (CC)

1 US/2.25 mm double pointed needles, or size to obtain required gauge

Gauge: 9 st/inch in mosaic pattern

Pattern Stitch: Slip all stitches purl wise, unless otherwise noted.

Round 1 & 2: MC (K1, Slip 2, K1, Slip 1, K1, Slip 2, K1, Slip 1) around

Round 3 & 4: CC (Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1) around

Round 5 & 6: MC (K2, Slip 1, K3, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1) around

Round 7 & 8: CC (K1, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K2) around

Round 9 & 10: MC (Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1) around

Round 11 & 12: CC (K2, Slip 1, K3, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1) around

Round 13 & 14: MC (K1, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K2) around

Round 15 & 16: CC (Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1) around

Round 17 & 18: MC (K1, Slip 2, K1, Slip 1, K1, Slip 2, K1, Slip 1) around

Round 19 & 20: CC (Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1) around

Round 21 & 22: MC (K1, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K2) around

Round 23 & 24: CC (K2, Slip 1, K3, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1) around

Round 25 & 26: MC (Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1) around

Round 27 & 28: CC (K1, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K2) around

Round 29 & 30: MC (K2, Slip 1, K3, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1) around

Round 31 & 32: CC (Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1, Slip 1, K2, Slip 1, K1) around

Repeat 32 rounds for pattern
