Scoubidou Sweater

Toddler's hip length, modified drop shoulder pullover with rolled edge collar. Generous crew style neck opening with back neck shaping makes a wide opening for easy dressing. The style is loose to fit over a T-shirt or turtle neck and long to give lots of room for growth in body and arms. The pattern is easy enough for beginners and fast enough for advanced knitters.

Materials:

8 balls Phildar Scoubidou 35% Rayon, 35% Nylon, 30% Acrylic 77 yds/50 grams or any washable worsted weight yarn to meet gauge

9 US/5.5 mm needles—2 sets

9 US/5.5 mm circular needles for collar, if desired

Gauge: 18 sts and 25 rows = 4 in/10 cm in
Stocking Stitch

Finished Measurements:

Chest: 27", Armhole: 11", Sleeve Length:

10" from drop shoulder, Center back

to wrist = 16", Body Length: 16".

Back:

1. Cast on 63 sts and work K1, P1 seed stitch for 2 rows. Work Stockinette Stitch until piece measures 10-1/4" (64 rows) (Lengthen or shorten here).
2. **Armhole shaping:** Cast off 7 sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Continue until armhole measures 5-3/8" (34 rows).
