

3. **Shape neck:** Work both sides at the same time. Work 16 sts. Slip the next 17 sts to a holder. With a second ball of yarn, work remaining 16 sts. Dec 1 st at neck edge every row once, until 15 sts remain.
4. Work even until armhole measures 5-3/4" (36 rows).
5. Cast off 15 shoulder sts loosely.

Front:

1. Follow steps 1 and 2 as for back.
2. Armhole shaping: Dec for armhole at both ends, as for back. Continue until armhole measures 3-3/4" (24 rows).
3. Shape neck. Work both sides at the same time. Work 20 sts. Slip the next 9 sts to a holder. With a second ball of yarn, work remaining 20 sts. Dec 1 st at neck edge every row 5 times, until 15 sts remain.
4. Work even until armhole measures 5-3/4" (36 rows).
5. Cast off 15 shoulder sts loosely.

Sleeves:

1. Cast on 29 sts.
2. Work K1 P1 seed stitch for 2 rows.
3. Work stocking stitch, increasing 1 st at each end of every 4th row 4 times, then every 5th row 7 times to 51 sts (53 rows total)
4. Work even until sleeve measures 10" (64 rows). (Lengthen or shorten here)
5. Cast off loosely.

Left shoulder seam: Sew front to back at left shoulder seam.

Rolled edge collar: Collar is worked in stocking stitch, which will roll naturally, with the purl side showing. If you prefer to work on a circular needle, and eliminate the collar seam, sew the right shoulder before starting the collar.

1. With right side of work facing, pick up and work 1 st from right back neck edge, 17 sts from back neck holder, 1 st from left back neck edge, 10 sts from left front neck edge, 9 sts from front neck holder and 10 sts from right front neck edge. Total 48 sts.
2. Work 1-1/2" (10 rows).
3. Cast off as follows:
K2, YO, pass 2 sts over the YO, * K1, YO, Pass 2 sts over the YO *. Repeat between * to last st, K1, pass stitch over. cut yarn and pull end through.
4. If required, sew remaining shoulder seam and work an invisible seam on the collar.

Finishing:

1. Sew sleeve top to armhole, easing to fit. Sew armhole castoff sections (on the front and back) to equal length along the armhole end of the sleeve side edges, then sew remaining side and sleeve seams.
2. Darn/weave/sew in all loose ends.
