

Paw Print Pattern:

1. K1, P1, K3, K2tog, YO (twice), K2tog (twice), YO (twice), K2tog, K14, P1, K1, P1
2. P1, K1, P15, K2,*P1, K1(Repeat from * 3 times), P2, K1, P1, K1
3. K1, P1, K5, K2tog, YO (twice), K2tog, K16, P1, K1, P1
4. P1, K1, P15, , K2, *P1, K1 (Repeat from * 3 times), P2, K1, P1, K1
5. Repeat Row 1
6. Repeat Row 2
7. Repeat Row 3
8. Repeat Row 4
9. K1, P1, K25, P1, K1, P1
10. P1, K1, P25, K1, P1, K1
11. K1, P1, K15, K2tog, YO (twice), K2tog (twice), YO (twice),K2tog, K2, P1, K1, P1
12. P1, K1, P3, K2,*P1, K1 (Repeat from * 3 times), P14, K1, P1, K1
13. **K1, P1, K17**, K2tog, YO (twice), K2tog, K4, P1, K1, P1
14. P1, K1, P3, K2, *P1, K1 (Repeat from * 3 times), P14, K1, P1, K1
15. Repeat Row 11
16. Repeat Row 12
17. Repeat Row 13
18. Repeat Row 14
19. K1, P1, K25, P1, K1, P1
20. P1, K1, P25, K1, P1, K1

Repeat Rows 1–20 until desired length. End with 4 rows of Seed Stitch and bind off loosely. This scarf looks great with or without fringe.
