Knitting Calendar • January 11, 2006

Row 5: With B1 knit

Row 6: With B1 purl

Row 7: Repeat row 3

Row 8: Repeat row 4

Row 9: Repeat row 1

Row 10: Repeat row 2

Directions:

With 13 US/9.0 mm needles, cast on 48 sts.

Work 2 knit rows in A, then work pattern sequence 21 times.

Repeat pattern sequence again using B2 instead of B1.

Repeat pattern sequence again using B3 instead of B1.

Repeat pattern sequence until desired length changing the "B" color each repeat.

Finishing: Using 10 US/6.0 mm crochet hook and A, crochet the following rounds:

Round 1 short edge: chain 5, * double crochet in 2nd knit stitch, chain 1, skip 1 knit stitch then double crochet in next, * repeat from * to *. Single crochet down side of last double crochet. Long edge: single crochet spacing evenly.

Round 2 short edge: Chain 5, * double crochet in the double crochet of the previous round, chain 1, * repeat from * to * end with 1 DC. Long edge: single crochet in each single crochet of the previous round.

Fringe: Using a piece of cardboard that is 9"/23 cm wide as a template, wrap the following yarns around: 1 strand of boucle, 2 strands of mohair, [2 strands of fine cotton](#). Attach in every other double crochet space. Sequence strands in the same order as you used in the shawl itself.
