

# Victorian Beaded Tea Cozy

Make tea time special. Fits a two-cup tea pot.

## Materials:

**Yarn:** 100 Yards Worsted weight yarn (sample worked in Encore by Plymouth)

**Needles:** 6 US double pointed needles

325 4 x 6 mm pony beads

**Gauge:** 5.25 sts = 1"/2.5 cm in stockinette stitch

## Directions:

### Begin working at top of tea cozy:

Cast on 8 stitches and divide onto 3 dpns to work in rounds.

Rnd 1: \*Push up bead (PUB), Purl into front and back of next stitch (Pfb), repeat from \* around. (16 sts)

Rnd 2 and all even number rnds through rnd 16: Purl.

Rnd 3: \*PUB, Pfb, P1, repeat from \* around. (24 sts)

Rnd 5: \*PUB, Pfb, P2, repeat from \* around. (32 sts)

Rnd 7: \*PUB, Pfb, P3, repeat from \* around. (40 sts)

Rnd 9: \*PUB, Pfb, P4, repeat from \* around. (48 sts)

Rnd 11: \*PUB, Pfb, P5, repeat from \* around. (56 sts)

Rnd 13: \*PUB, Pfb, P6, repeat from \* around. (64 sts)

~~Rnd 15: \*PUB, P8, repeat from \* around.~~ Delete this Round
