### FLiP, the Fun Little Purse

Knitting Calendar • April 12, 2006

Round 7: \*K sts on needle 1. On needle 2, k1, ssk, k12, k2tog, k1; rep from \* for sts on needles 3 and 4. (68 sts)

Round 8: \*K sts on needle 1. On needle 2, sl 1, k to last st, sl 1; rep from \* for needles 3 and 4.

Round 9: K.

Round 10: as Round 8.

Round 11 **Decrease round:** \*K sts on needle 1. On needle 2, k1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts on needle, k2tog, k1; rep from \* for sts on needles 3 and 4. (64 sts)

Repeat rounds 8 through 11, until there are 6 sts remaining on needles # 2 and 4. (48 sts in round)

Next round: Knit 18 sts of first needle, then cast off sts of remaining 3 needles as if to purl.

#### **Shape purse flap:**

Keeping the edge stitch in garter stitch, work back and forth in stockinette stitch for 6 rows on the remaining 18 sts.

Still keeping the edge stitch in garter stitch, decrease 1 stitch each side every other row until 6 stitches remain.

Cast off last 6 stitches.

#### **Finishing:**

Pick up 4 stitches on 1 of the side edges and work I-cord strap for desired length. Attach I cord to other side of purse.

Sew a button on the front of purse near the bottom. Make a loop at the bottom of the flap to go over the button.

#### **Variations:**

The front and back can be worked in a 2 x 2 or 3 x 3 basket pattern. Sides can be worked in 1 x 1 or 2 x 2 ribbing.
