Maria's Cardigan

Sizes: Ladies' Small, Medium, Large, and X-Large.

Materials:

Yarn: 350–400g Schaffhauser silk and wool mix, 70% silk, 30% wool; 1,680-1,920 m of fine yarn for first two sizes, add 50 g more for Large and 100g for X-large approx.

Needles: 4 US/3.5 mm

5-1/2 US/4 mm

5 or 6 buttons

Gauge: 24 sts and 36 rows = 4"/10 cm

Stitch Pattern: Multiple of 6 sts and 4 rows.

Row 1: K3, wo, sl1, k2tog, pssso (pass sl stitch over), wo, k3, repeat to end.

Row 2: Purl all sts.

Row 3: Knit all sts.

Row 4: Purl all sts.

Repeat these 4 rows until desired length is complete.

Directions:

Back: With 4 US/3.5 mm needles cast on 90, 96, 102, 108 sts.

Knit 4 rows.

Change to 4mm needles and work in pattern until piece measures 13"/33 cm for small size.

Add 1"/2. 5 cm for med size and 2"/5 cm for the other sizes.
