Mittens for the Family

Knitting Calendar • October 5, 2006

Thumb gusset: Continue using fleece

Row 1: Knit 15 (17, 19) sts., place marker on needle, increase 1 st in each of the next 2 sts., place marker, K 15 (17, 19) sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: K to marker, slip marker, inc. in next st and knit to one st before marker, inc. 1 st, slip marker, and knit to end of row.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until there are 10 (12, 14) sts. On the Knit row, k to 1 st before marker and inc in that st (add 1 st), put next 10 (12, 14) sts on holder for thumb, inc 1 st in next st, and knit to end of row.

Purl across next row joining sts for the hand and leaving thumb sts on holder.

Hand: Work even, adding fleece, until mitten measures 8 (9, 10-1/2)"/21 (22.9, 26.7) cm or desired length, ending with a purl row.

Start top shaping:

Row 1: K2, K2 tog. repeat to end.

Rows 2 and 4: Purl.

Row 3: K1, K2 tog. repeat to end.

Row 5: K2 tog. repeat to end.

Cut yarn, leaving a tail, draw through remaining sts using a yarn needle and fasten inside, sewing side seam.

Thumb: Work 10 (12, 14) sts until thumb measures 1-1/2 (2, 2-1/2)"/3.8 (5, 6.4) cm K2tog across row and finish as on hand.
